SUBJECT: Establish a Nonrecurring Cost (NC) Charge for M933A1 Cartridge, DSCA Policy 15-26

The attached Finding, signed by the Director, Defense Security Cooperation Agency (DSCA), approves a NC recoupment pro rata charge for the sale, coproduction, or licensed production of the items shown on the Finding table.
