SUBJECT: Update of Security Assistance Management Manual (SAMM) Table C4.T2., Country, International Organization, and Regional Codes and Foreign Military Sales (FMS) Eligibility, DSCA Policy 16-48 [SAMM E-Change 324]

The Air Force has identified a requirement for an FMS code to be used for cases involving the NATO Alliance Ground System (AGS).

Accordingly, SAMM Table C4.T2., Country, International Organization, and Regional Codes and FMS Eligibility, is updated as below to establish a new FMS code for NATO AGS.
