SUBJECT: Update of Figure C8.F1. of the Security Assistance Management Manual (SAMM),
DSCA Policy 17-31 [SAMM E-Change 363]

This memorandum updates Figure C8.F1. of the SAMM to provide additional information on the process for designating defense articles for Enhanced End-Use Monitoring (EEUM). Specifically, this memorandum revises Figure C8.F1 to distinguish between the standard and non-standard process for designating defense articles for EEUM.

Effective immediately, Chapter 8 of the SAMM is updated as attached. This change will be included in the version of the SAMM found on the DSCA Web Page as SAMM E-Change 363. 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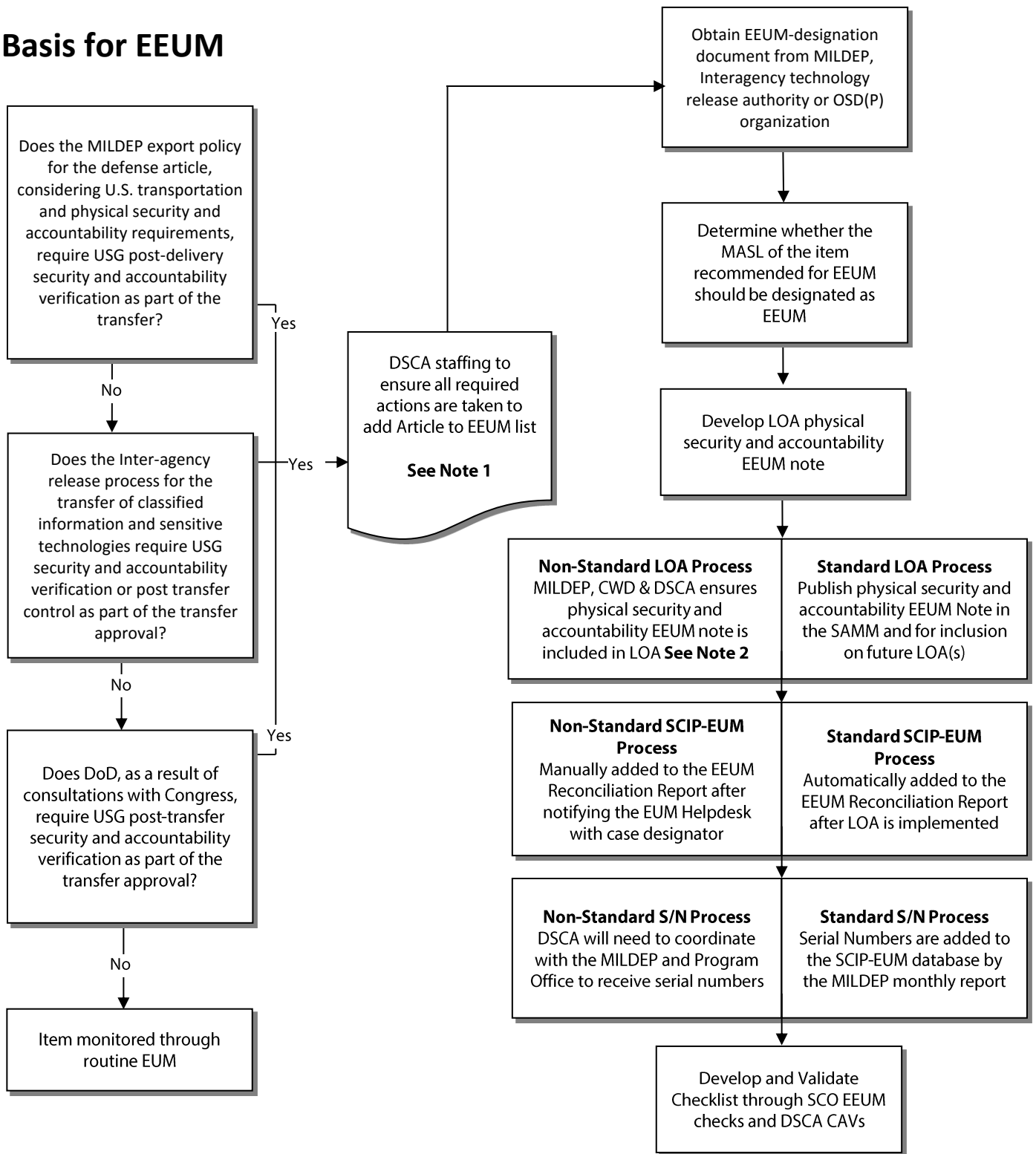

Note 1: DSCA staffing will include Security Assistance (AMP-EUM will lead staffing actions), and Strategy Directorates, the Office of General Counsel, the appropriate Military Department and the Defense Technology Security Administration.

Note 2: Non-Standard process is for items not generally treated as EEUM but designated as EEUM only for specific FMS export sales.
