SUBJECT: Rescission and replacement of Program Codes to track Fiscal Year (FY) 2017/18 Counter-ISIL Train and Equip Fund (CTEF) for Iraq, 2017/18 Counter-ISIL Train and Equip Fund (CTEF) for Syria and Pakistan Stability Operations Funds (PSOF) DSCA Policy 17-35 [SAMM E-Change 366]

Effective immediately, policy memos 17-23 and 17-24 are hereby rescinded, program codes "2E" and "2F" will not be used to track any Counter-ISIL Train and Equip Fund (CTEF) programs and will be replaced by the program codes assigned in this memorandum. Program Code "3T" is assigned to track FY 2017/18 Counter-ISIL Train and Equip Fund (CTEF) for Iraq specific programs. Program Code "3U" is assigned to track FY 2017/18 Counter-ISIL Train and Equip Fund (CTEF) for Syria specific programs. Funds for CTEF are provided by Division C of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2017 and are available for obligation until September 30, 2018. Management and execution of 2017/2018 CTEF Iraq and Syria specific programs will comply with guidance provided in the Security Assistance Management Manual (SAMM), Chapter 15.



Also effective immediately, policy memo 17-28 is hereby rescinded, program code "2G" will not be used to track any Pakistan Stability Operations Fund (PSOF) programs and the "2G" program code will be replaced by "3V" as assigned in this memorandum. Program code "3V" is assigned to track FY 2016/17 Pakistan Stability Operations Funds (PSOF) programs. Funds for PSOF are provided by Division C of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2016 and are available for obligation until September 30, 2017. Management and execution of 2016/2017 PSOF programs will comply with guidance provided in the Security Assistance Management Manual (SAMM), Chapter 15.
