SUBJECT: Assignment of Program Codes “7N” to track Fiscal Year (FY) 2018/2019 Counter-ISIL Train and Equip Fund (CTEF) Programs for Iraq and “7T” to Track FY 2018/2019 Counter-ISIL Train and Equip Fund (CTEF) Programs in Syria, DSCA Policy 18-02 [SAMM E-Change 348]

Effective immediately, Program Code “7N” is assigned to track FY 2018/2019 funds appropriated for the Counter-ISIL Train and Equip Fund (CTEF) program for Iraq and “7T” is assigned to track FY 2018/2019 funds appropriated for the CTEF program in Syria. Funds are provided under Division C of the Bipartisan Budget Act of 2018 (P.L. 115-123) and will remain available for obligation until September 30, 2019. Management and execution of FY 2018/2019 “7N” and “7T” programs must comply with guidance provided in the Security Assistance Management Manual (SAMM), Chapter 15.

The SAMM Table C4.T2B, Security Cooperation (SC) Customer and Regional Codes and FMS Eligibility, is updated as follows:
