SUBJECT: Assignment of Program Code “QB” to track Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 Afghanistan Security Forces Fund, DSCA Policy 18-55 [SAMM E-Change 405]

Effective immediately, Program Code “QB” is assigned to track FY 2019 Afghanistan Security Forces Funds (ASFF). Funds are available to provide assistance to the security forces of Afghanistan. Funds are provided under Division A of the Department of Defense and Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education Appropriations Act, 2019 and Continuing Appropriations Act, 2019, (P.L. 115-245) and will remain available until September 30, 2020.

Management and execution of FY 2019 ASFF “QB” program will comply with guidance provided in the Security Assistance Management Manual (SAMM), Chapter 15.


