Security Assistance Management Manual (SAMM), E-Change 220

The following is inserted to the SAMM immediately following Section C.4.5.5., to read as follows:

<u>C4.5.6.</u> <u>Military Uniforms.</u> U.S. combat military uniforms may be eligible for sale or transfer to foreign countries via FMS. Each type of uniform must be designated as excess by the U.S. Armed Forces (U.S. military and U.S. Coast Guard), must no longer be actively used by the U.S. Armed Forces or Reserves, and cannot contain Identification Friend or Foe (IFF) technology. Contact DSCA Strategy Directorate for a list of combat military uniforms that are eligible for FMS. See 10 U.S.C. 771 and 14 U.S.C. 484.
