SUBJECT: Establish Nonrecurring Cost (NC) Charge – AN/APG-82 (V)1 Active Electronically  
Scanned Array (AESA) Radar, DSCA Policy Memo 13-47

The attached Finding, signed by the Director, Defense Security Cooperation Agency, approves a nonrecurring cost (NC) recoupment pro rata charge for the sale, coproduction, or licensed production of the items shown on the Finding table.
