SUBJECT: Assignment of Program Code “Q4” to track Fiscal Year (FY) 2014 Funds Provided for Global Peacekeeping Operations Initiative (GPOI), DSCA Policy 14-06, [SAMM E-Change 248]

Effective immediately, Program Code “Q4” is assigned to track and execute FY14 funds provided for GPOI. The management and execution of these programs will comply with guidance provided in the Security Assistance Management Manual (SAMM), Chapter 15.


obligations in compliance with the terms of the appropriation authority. All projects must be completed before the funds' cancellation date.
