Policy 17-04 [SAMM E-Change 344]**

Per letter dated 18 April 2016, the Brazil Ministry of Defense confirmed their willingness to participate in the Accelerated Case Closure Procedures (ACCP) Program. Effective immediately, all cases for this customer will be included in the accelerated procedures.


DSCA requests all organizations ensure that the FMS system(s) they maintain are updated to reflect this revised information. Likewise, DSCA will ensure that Defense Security Assistance Management System (DSAMS) is updated as appropriate. Request Defense Finance and Accounting Services (DFAS) transfer all cases already closed directly from "CI" (non-ACCP participant) to "C3" (ACCP final) status.

This policy also updates all SAMM tables to ensure Foreign Military Financing (FMF) recipient countries are listed as eligible for ACCP. Per Security Assistance Management Manual (SAMM) A7.C3.3.1, Foreign Partners receiving FMF funding are required to participate in the

ACCP for all of their FMS cases regardless of the funding source. In addition, administrative updates are being incorporated into both the SAMM Chapter 4, Table C4.T2 (a); and Appendix 7, Chapter 3, Table A7.C3.T1 (Reconciliation and Closure Guide (RCG)) to ensure a consistent listing of ACCP participants across the two tables.

Attached are the updated ACCP Participating Country Tables listing program participants including those updated via this policy memo. This update will be incorporated into the SAMM Chapter 4, Table C4.T2 (a) and Appendix 7, Chapter 3, Table A7.C3.T1 (RCG).
