SUBJECT: Assignment of Program Code “Q7” to track Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 Funds Global Peacekeeping Operations Initiative (GPOI), DSCA Policy 17-29 [SAMM E-Change 361]

Effective immediately, Program Code "Q7" is assigned to track FY 2017 Global Peacekeeping Operations Initiative (GPOI) programs. Division J, Title IV, Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2017 (P.L. 115-31) provides funding for this authority through September 30, 2021 if the funds are initially obligated by September 30, 2017. Management and execution of FY 2017 GPOI programs will comply with guidance provided in the Security Assistance Management Manual (SAMM), Chapter 15.

The SAMM Table C4.T2, Country and International Organization Codes and FMS Eligibility, is updated as follows:

The appropriation available for Q7 Letters of Offer and Acceptance (LOAs) is recorded in the SAMM, Table C15.T2., Appropriation Authority column, and shall be cited on each Q7 LOA in the Funds Expiration, Purpose, Availability, and Amount note.

Funding associated with Q7 LOAs will be fully expended and Q7 cases will be reconciled and closed as soon as possible, but no later than two months before the funds cancellation date.
