SUBJECT: Update of Figure C8.F1. of the Security Assistance Management Manual (SAMM), DSCA Policy 17-31 [SAMM E-Change 363]

This memorandum updates Figure C8.F1. of the SAMM to provide additional information on the process for designating defense articles for Enhanced End-Use Monitoring (EEUM). Specifically, this memorandum revises Figure C8.F1 to distinguish between the standard and non-standard process for designating defense articles for EEUM.


