**SUBJECT:** Establish Nonrecurring Cost (NC) Charges – Ship, Frigate, Multi-Mission Surface Combatant (MMSC) and COMBATSS-21, DSCA Policy 18-15

The attached Finding, signed by the Director, Defense Security Cooperation Agency (DSCA), approves a NC recoupment pro rata charge for the sale, coproduction, or licensed production of the items shown on the Finding table.

In accordance with the Arms Export Control Act, any country requesting a waiver of NC charges must request the waiver in writing prior to finalization of the purchase, if it is to be approved.


