**SUBJECT:** Remove Tube-Launched, Optically-Tracked, Wire-Guided (TOW-2B) Missiles from the Enhanced End-Use Monitoring (EEUM) list and monitor under Routine End-Use Monitoring (DSCA 21-61) [SAMM E-Change 542]

Effective immediately, this memorandum incorporates E-Change 542 into the Security Assistance Management Manual (SAMM) by removing the TOW-2B from the list of defense articles identified for EEUM in Table C8.T4. In addition, the required physical security and accountability note for TOW-2B Missiles is removed from Appendix 6 of the SAMM.

In July 1995, when the TOW-2B missiles physical security and accountability note was established, the LOA Standard Terms and Conditions (ST&C) did not address the U.S. government's right to conduct an inspection and physical inventory of transferred defense articles. However, since the current content of ST&C paragraph 2.7 addresses the Purchaser's obligation to allow U.S. government to conduct an inspection and physical inventory, the existing TOW-2B missiles physical security and accountability note is now redundant with current ST&C and is no longer warranted. Further, the TOW-2B does not meet the current criteria for EEUM designation established by SAMM Figure C8.F1.

As a result of this memorandum, all TOW-2B missiles transferred prior to this policy memorandum will now be subject to routine EUM monitoring.

1. In Table C8.T4. “Defense Articles Designated for EEUM for all FMS-eligible Countries”, remove the following line:

EEUM-Designated Defense Articles	Description
Tube-Launched, Optically-Tracked, Wire-Guided Missiles (TOW-2B)	TOW-2B Missiles only.

2. In Appendix 6, remove the following note:
