of Program Codes “~~L3~~” “UB” to track Fiscal Year 2022/2023 Funding for
Peacekeeping Operations in Africa [SAMM E-Change 590]

Effective immediately, program code “~~L3~~” “UB” is assigned to track Fiscal Year (FY)
2022/2023 funds appropriated for Peacekeeping Operations (PKO) pursuant to the Department
of State (State), Foreign Operations, and Related Program Appropriations Act (Division K, P.L.
117-103) and that the State has programmed for PKO activities in Africa.

Instructions for preparation of “~~L3~~” “UB” Letter of Offer and Acceptance (LOA)
documents are found in the SAMM, Table C15.T5. Standard notes applicable to BPC programs
are found in the SAMM, Appendix 6, LOA Notes Listing. Funding associated with “~~L3~~” “UB”
LOAs will be fully expended and cases will be reconciled and closed two months before the
funds cancellation date.
