Manual and Information Systems [SAMM E-Change 778]

This policy memorandum (PM) removes the following Security Cooperation Customer Codes (SCCCs) in [Table C4.T2](#), (and [Table AP8.T2](#), - Security Assistance and Security Cooperation Programs Code Listing, as necessary) of the SAMM as the SCCCs were not utilized by the Security Cooperation Community:

A8	Organization of Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE)
C3	Economic Community of Central African States (ECCAS)

Y3	Section 1107 of FY04 Supplemental (Train and Equip Authority) for the New Iraqi Army
Z4	Syria Train and Equip Program, FY 2017/18

Further, the above SCCCs and “2G,” “C7,” and “C8” will be removed from Defense Integrated Finance System and the Defense Security Assistance Management System, as

applicable (use for “2G,” “C7,” and “C8” SCCC’s was rescinded by DSCA PM 17-35 and PM 22-82). All of the SCCC’s mentioned may be removed from other financial and logistics systems if applicable.
